1. AG Industries Update

AG Industries provided 3rd party report regarding fly rocking incident as well as a corrective action plan. The findings of the investigation determined the fly rocking incident was caused by a miscommunication on time ultimately leading to errors on behalf of the contracted blaster. The corrective action plan outlines providing clearer communication in the future,

AG Industries provided proofs of insurance for both themselves and Austin Powders (contracted blaster)
